In line with directives from the Church of Scotland, Currie Kirk Session met via a Zoom meeting on Tuesday 14 July to discuss the possibility of opening our Church Buildings for Private Prayer.

After much debate and discussion around the Guidelines and Risk Assessments to be implemented, Session agreed NOT to open up our Church Buildings (the Kirk and the Gibson Craig Halls) at this time. The Lockdown rules are continuously changing and we are taking advice and direction from the National Church. We will keep you informed as the situation evolves.

Many of you will be disappointed with our decision, but the safety and wellbeing of our congregation and volunteers is our paramount concern.
